Discipline and Trauma Cycle:

Children/youth that have been traumatized may not feel safe and may enter a hypervigilant state. This can lead to distress behaviors when the child/youth becomes overwhelmed or triggered.

When demands are placed on the individual that they are unable to meet the situation may escalate. This may lead to fight, flight or freeze behavior, which may lead to punishment and retraumatization.

Traumatic for Parents: The use of punitive discipline can also be traumatic to parents. Parents are also impacted by past trauma. When parents feel unsafe, they may also escalate to a fight or flight response. This can lead to additional trauma and may lead the parents to be hypervigilant. In a hypervigilant state, parents may be more likely to use punitive approaches.
